- Applicant acknowledges that the competition process is assisted by volunteer judges who have no direct affiliation with NIHF, and that Applicant has been advised to obtain patent protection on the Invention. - Applicant acknowledges that it is voluntarily submitting its invention to the competition for award consideration.
- Applicant hereby releases NIHF, its board members, officers, employees, sponsors, volunteer judges, and their respective successors and assigns, from any and all liability in connection with Applicant’s submission of its application, the disclosure of the Invention and/or Applicant’s participation in the competition.
- If Applicant is awarded competition winnings of \$600 or more, a 1099 will be issued to Applicant at the conclusion of the tax year. Applicants who are non-United States citizens will be subject to a 30% withholding from all competition winnings and will be asked to complete the appropriate income tax withholding forms as required by the Internal Revenue Service.
- Applicant is over 18 years of age and is currently or was previously enrolled at a college/university in accordance with the competition Rules and Requirements, which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
