- Applicant acknowledges that the competition process is assisted by volunteer judges who have no direct affiliation with NIHF.
- Applicant acknowledges that they are voluntarily submitting their invention to the competition for awards consideration.
- Applicant hereby releases NIHF, its board members, officers, employees, sponsors, volunteer judges, and their respective successors and assignees, from any and all liability in connection with Applicant’s submission of its application, the disclosure of the Invention and/or Applicant’s participation in the competition.
- If Applicant is awarded competition winnings of \$600 or more, a 1099 will be issued to Applicant at the conclusion of the tax year.
