CAMP PARENT BEST PRACTICES

Giveaway Items

- Pass out the pencils, hacky sacks, pencil pouches and nutty putty at events such as field days, school
 productions, assemblies, fairs, community festivals and PTO/PTA meetings.
- Share with your child's friends at birthday parties or sleepovers to get them excited for Camp Invention.

Flyers

- Distribute flyers at school and community events, PTO/PTA nights or parent/teacher conferences.
- Ask local businesses such as pizza shops, libraries and workout studios to hand out flyers.
- If your school has a digital flyer distribution method, please work with your Camp Director to receive a digital version of our flyer.

Posters

- Write your local camp information including dates, times, grade range and location.
- Hang posters in community grocery stores, hair salons, ice cream parlors, libraries, bookstores, post offices, recreation centers and neighborhood centers.

Community/Events

- Promote Camp Invention at sporting events, carnivals, book fairs, libraries, PTO/PTA nights, church functions, community rec centers and daycares.
- Find free, local newspapers, calendars, event listings, magazines or newsletters, or use patch.com to list your program information.
- Utilize online sites and apps such as Nextdoor to spread the word.
- Use your Director's pre-made write-ups that include specific Camp Invention information to submit to your school's newsletter or area publications.
- Post your program information on local neighborhood websites/association pages.

Email

- Forward Camp Invention emails to other parents in your community.
- Use the current Camp Invention roster from your Director to send a thank you/welcome email to parents and participants, encouraging them to invite friends and family to sign up for Camp Invention.

Social Media

- Create a Facebook event to connect parents in the community and spread awareness of your local Camp Invention program (see your Director for how to create a Facebook event).
- Like and share Camp Invention's social media posts on Facebook and Twitter.
- Invite friends and fellow parents to like and share our social media pages.

Additional Ideas and Tips

- Create a Camp Invention bulletin board in the lobby of your school.
- Arrange to organize a table or booth during a spring school function. We can provide hands-on activities for these events.
- Host an informational demonstration assembly with hands-on activities, which we can provide.
- Collaborate with your Director on raising funds for your program.
