PROGRAM SCHEDULE

IN PERSON

- Participants will be grouped by age and rotate through four modules per day plus our games module, experiencing five modules throughout the week.

AT HOME

- Participants will be grouped by age and take part in one full module per day, with the fifth day being a culmination of the core four modules. Outdoor fun is also scheduled daily (weather permitting).

PARTICIPANTS

- Participants will be listed as At Home or In Person on the roster for easy roster management.
- All participants will be included in roster totals for compensation calculations.

**Participants will not need to bring any technology to in-person camps.*



MATERIALS

IN PERSON

- Participants will be provided with some shared materials that can be sanitized, as well as individual materials to use for modules.
- Materials will be shipped to the program site.

AT HOME

- Participants will receive an Innovator's Toolkit to build their own home workshop, in addition to the materials needed to complete each activity.
- Materials will be shipped to individual homes; Instructors will receive their own box of materials for instructional purposes.

While many of the hands-on experiences are the same for both At Home and In Person, a few of the activities have been modified to ensure participants have the best experience possible depending on the delivery format. For example, Take Apart is an optional activity for at-home participants and has differentiated options for in-person participants.

PROGRAM TEAM

IN PERSON

- Instructors will lead one to two modules with rotating groups of participants per day.
- Instructors will present curriculum and use technology to share supporting videos and instructions for the various activities.
- Directors will be responsible for all parent communication.
- Leaders-In-Training will take part in in-person opportunities only.
- Leadership Interns will take part in in-person opportunities only.

AT HOME

- Instructors will lead five modules, one module per day, using provided scripts and interactive presentations.
- Instructors will use technology to lead activities with interactive videos and scripts shared via video meeting, using the platform of their choice (e.g., Zoom, Google Classroom, etc.).
- Instructors will be on site to assist in-person camp participants and Instructors when not leading online experiences, enabling the Director to more efficiently manage both scenarios.
- Instructors will have contact with parents via daily newsletter emails.
